The Continuing Education Oversight Committee at The C.G. Jung Institute of SF wants to clarify via this memo today – August 27, 2026 – that we were informed by our CE providers that we can no longer give CEs to faculty. Faculty can claim CEs for the classes they teach via their licensing board.
