Please send your submissions to Managing Editor LeeAnn Pickrell at leeannpickrell@me.com.

- The article should be submitted as a Word file.
- The text should be double-spaced and please use Times New Roman, 12 pt. font.
- Insert a line space between each paragraph and do not indent the paragraphs.
- The journal uses the Chicago Manual of Style, author-date system for references. See https://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide/citation-guide-2.html.
- Following the bibliography, in the same file, include a bio, abstract, and key words.
 - The bio should be 50 to 75 words and include an email address and, if desired, postal address for correspondence.
 - The abstract should be approximately 100 words.
 - Include approximately 5 to 10 key words.
- The journal encourages the inclusion of any images that fit with your work. Images should be submitted as 300 dpi tiff or jpeg files.
