Guidelines

We now use a Submission Portal for submissions and peer reviews. To submit a paper, click the green **Go to Submission Site** button at <https://www.tandfonline.com/UJUN>. For feature articles, you will need to submit two versions of the article, one with all the author details included and one without author details.

Note that it is the author's responsibility to address any ethical issues and permissions around sharing case material. Unless specific permission has been granted, all patient material should be anonymized and composite examples used to protect confidentiality.

- The article should be submitted as a Word file. Feature articles should be 9000 words or less. Reviews and Blocks & Mortars essays should be approximately 1500 words.
- The text should be double-spaced and please use Times New Roman, 12 pt. font.
- Insert a line space between each paragraph and do not indent the paragraphs.
- The journal uses the Chicago Manual of Style 18, author-date system for references. See https://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide/citation-guide-2.html.
- Following the bibliography, in the same file, include a bio, abstract, and key words.
 - The bio should be 75 to 100 words and include an email address and, if desired, postal address for correspondence.
 - The abstract should be approximately 100 words.
 - Include approximately 5 to 10 key words.
- The journal encourages the inclusion of any images that fit with your work. Images should be submitted as 300 dpi tiff or jpeg files.

We look forward to receiving your submission. Please note that we do not accept any work created by AI (artificial intelligence) and that any use of AI in research must be documented and original sources should be consulted and cited.
